For a total of 168.5 hours


Members attended a total of 10 hours of Training.

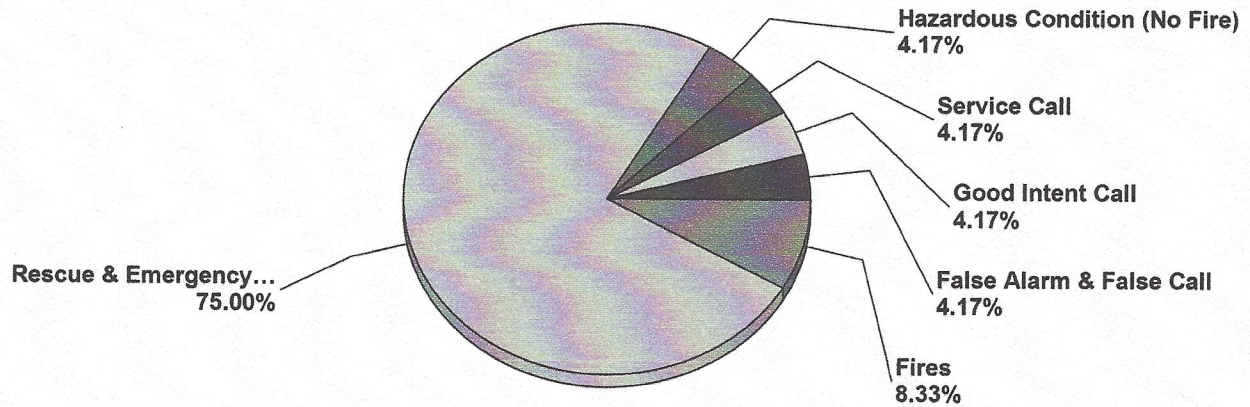
